Our training programmes for the créche workers will directly affect the lives of up to 150 children, many of whom need intensive input if they are to cope when starting school in the future. We will be working in partnership with The Dopstop Association on the Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder programme.

We are excited to announce our move into a new office and training room space at MANUKA on Main Road, Somerset West. We hope to be settled there by the middle of February and can then start our crèche worker group training sessions. Hands-On Days


