# GENERAL PEBBLES NEWS



In 2009, Pebbles will be working with 11 wine farms, supporting 9 créches and 9 after-school clubs, two créches in the suburbs of Lwandle and Kayamandi, and improving the education of over 500 children. We will also be working with the farm owners, parents and communities to try and offer the children the best that they deserve. Without the help of our sponsors, donors and supporters, none of this could be possible, and without the dedication and hard work of our wonderful staff, none of this would be achieved!









FOLLOW US ON

The créches continue to flourish, supported by our training programme; provision of resources; on-site special needs training; monthly educational trips and the new toy library.

Our range of activities in the after-school clubs have been extended to include a homework programme, a lifeskills programme, sport activities, drama workshops, music lessons, lifestyle workshops, special needs support, as well as their monthly educational trips. We also want to include weekend programmes and holiday camps for these children this year, as these are the occasions when they can be most vulnerable while unoccupied and unsupervised.

This year we will be offering 4 parent workshops per farm, to assist the parents with topics such as Substance Abuse, HIV/AIDS, Parenting Skills and Money Management.

### Toy Library

The Pebbles Mobile Toy Library, jointly funded by the WOSA CCT UK Importers Committee and the SA Golf Open Championship, is now finally on the road!

After a few delays appointing a member of staff to manage the project, we finally found the wonderful Michelle Hendricks, who joined the Pebbles team in mid-February.

The toy library is now delivering new toys every fortnight to almost 100 créche children, which will help them develop their communication skills, imaginative play skills, fine motor control, hand-eye coordination and numeracy skills - and all from just playing!

## New Créche Building

The second newsflash is the new créche building that we have provided for the children of Bellevue wine farm. Their old créche building simply did not give enough space for over 25 children, and was also well past



retirement state, so this new building will give the children a clean, waterproof, stimulating environment in which to learn and grow.

The créche comes fully equipped with a baby room, a bottle-feeding and changing area, a kitchen, a baby toilet and a big classroom for the older children. We would like to offer a HUGE thank you to JF Hillebrand for sponsoring this créche building and assure you that this will dramatically improve the lives and educational opportunities of these children.
