FIRST THOUSAND DAYS PROGRAMME (3 MONTHS - 2.5 YEARS)

The Pebbles Project First Thousand Days (FTD) Programme aims to provide support to children aged 3 months to 2.5 years in terms of nutrition, healthcare, and education.

Early Childhood Development Programme (2.5 - 5 years)

The Pebbles Project Early Childhood Development (ECD) Programme aims to develop children aged 2.5 to 5 years holistically in order to create a solid foundation for lifelong learning and well-being.

The Pebbles Project Early Adulthood Programme (EAP) supports young adults from farming communities to enrol in further education or training opportunities to gain important life and practical skills to enable them to seek gainful employment and to ultimately become self-sufficient and responsible members of society.

Pebbles Clinic and Health and Wellness Service

The Pebbles clinic is situated on Villiera wine farm in Stellenbosch in the Western Cape and services the neighbouring farming communities. The Pebbles clinic provides primary healthcare, wellness, and dental services to Pebbles beneficiaries, their families and community members. Services for the children are provided free of charge and adults pay a nominal fee. Transport is provided and the clinic operates on an appointment system to reduce waiting times thereby overcoming the challenges posed by local government clinics.
