The Pebbles Project Maternal Health Initiative was implemented in 2016 and operates from the Pebbles Clinic in Stellenbosch and the Pebbles Project Twinings Mobile Health Clinic in Clanwilliam. #### THE PEBBLES KITCHEN

The Pebbles Kitchen was launched in March 2019 thanks to funding received from the Stichting Garcia Foundation and Goede Mensen. The Pebbles Kitchen is located in Klein Joostenberg, Stellenbosch, and is a bustling hub where approximately 3000 nutritious meals are prepared daily. Among these, 1300 meals are earmarked for Pebbles Project beneficiaries, while the remainder is distributed to various NPOs and ECD centers. These wholesome meals are freshly cooked, then frozen and dispatched to Pebbles Project educational centers spanning Stellenbosch, Franschhoek, Somerset West, Wellington, the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley, Grabouw, Citrusdal, and Clanwilliam.

Moreover, the Pebbles Kitchen extends its support beyond its immediate beneficiaries, catering to the needs of other NPOs and educational centers. The aim is to expand this network, ensuring that nutritious meals reach a broader spectrum of NPOs, educational institutions, and clinics across the greater Winelands area.

#### PEBBLES CLINIC AND HEALTH AND WELLNESS SERVICE

The Pebbles clinic is situated on Villiera wine farm in Stellenbosch in the Western Cape and services the neighbouring farming communities. The Pebbles clinic provides primary healthcare, wellness, and dental services to Pebbles beneficiaries, their families and community members. Services for the children are provided free of charge and adults pay a nominal fee. Transport is provided and the clinic operates on an appointment system to reduce waiting times thereby overcoming the challenges posed by local government clinics.
